

2.6.1-METHODS OF ASSESSMENT OF LEARNING OUTCOMES

- 1. The Program outcome measures for BDS & MDS curriculum are defined based on the knowledge, Skill and attitude components. [KSA Component]
- 2. The defined measures are matched between Program specific learning outcomes, course outcome and key performance indicators. [Each statement to be defined to reflect the 3 parameters]

- 1. Each course is given a course code by the dental education department and course director for each subject is defined to implement, monitor and execute the teaching and learning process in a effective manner.
- 2. The core areas of curriculum are identified and learning outcomes are defined by dental education department. [Awareness, Understanding and Proficiency Component]
- 3. The assessment of the outcome measures are done as follows for **Theory and Practical** sessions.
- **4. Question paper should reflect the [KSA Component]** Question paper for theory session should reflect the knowledge, cognitive skill and Psychomotor skill component as determined during the planning stages of curriculum.



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THEORY:

Knowledge and cognitive skill component is assessed by written examination using Short essay questions long essay questions and viva Voce

PRACTICAL:

- 1. Knowledge component is assessed by Viva Voce
- 2. Case selection, Diagnosis, Treatment plan and delivery and inter personal are assessed before initiating the practical session.
- 3. Psychomotor component is assessed during practical session
- 4. Patient handling, pain management, armamentarium arrangement, communication, sterilization practices and post instructions and counseling skills are assessed.

Practical / Clinical Examination: 200 Marks
